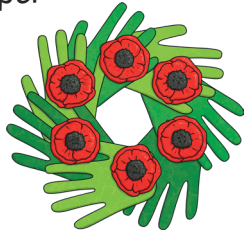


How to Make a Poppy Wreath

3 You will need:

- 8 • various shades of green card
- 11 • red tissue paper
- 13 • black card
- 15 • glue stick
- 16 • pencil
- 17 • scissors



18 Method



- 28 1. Draw around your hand on the green card. Repeat
30 six times.
- 35 2. Cut out your handprints.
- 45 3. Overlap the handprints in a circle shape and glue
47 them together.
- 58 4. Cut out 18 small circles of red tissue paper. Ensure
63 they are the same size.
- 74 5. Place glue in the centre of the circles. Glue three
82 circles together to create the petals. Repeat until
86 you have six poppies.
- 98 6. Cut six small circles out of the black card for the
102 centre of the poppies.
- 114 7. Add a black circle to the middle of each of the
119 poppies and glue in place.

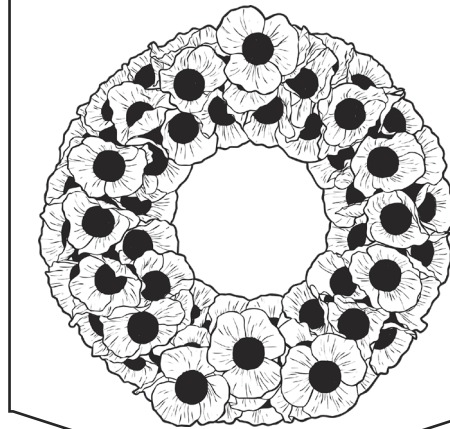
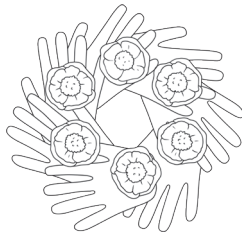

Answers



1. How many circles of red tissue paper do you need to cut out?
 - 6
 - 12
 - 18

You need to cut out 18 circles.

3. Look at step 3 of the method. Why might the author have specifically chosen the imperative verb **overlap**?

Pupils' own responses, such as: I think the author chose 'overlap' so the person making the wreath would know to not place the hands in a circle without them touching.



4. Predict what would happen if we removed step 5 from the method.
Pupils' own responses, such as: I think the petals would fall off the wreath once it was picked up.
