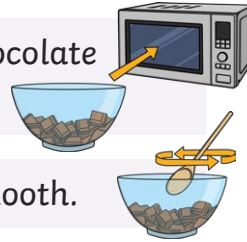

- 32 • hundreds and thousands

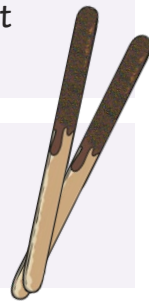
33 Method:

59 2. Slowly, stir the chocolate until it is smooth.

68 3. Twirl the breadstick in the chocolate so that
75 about 10cm of the length is covered.



84 4. Dip the covered part in the hundreds and
92 thousands, turning it slowly so that all the
95 chocolate is covered.

104 5. Stand the breadstick upright in a jug and
112 place it in the fridge to set.

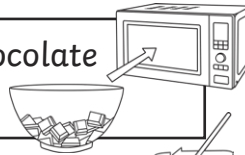
