Reading

Please continue reading regularly with your child and please make sure your child has their reading record in school every day. Daily reading with an adult at home has been proven to make a huge impact on progress. Remember to discuss your child's book with them and encourage them to ask and answer questions about the characters, what might happen next and the setting. We will continue to send home weekly reading comprehensions for them to complete and bring back into school for DoJo and House points!

Spelling

Spellings will continue to be stuck into spelling books every few weeks. Please continue to encourage your child to practise these at home in readiness for their quizzes.



Design and Technology

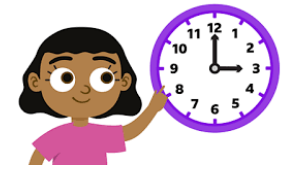
This half term we will be designing and making a moving vehicle. Please could you collect some junk modelling materials for your child to make their vehicle from and bring them to school in a named carrier bag on Monday 8th June.



Literacy

In our literacy learning, we are reading the texts 'The Water Protectors' by Carole Lindstrom, followed by 'The Journey Home' by Frann Preston-Gannon. We will be working on using describing words and writing in the

past tense and will be focussing on using capital letters and full stops in our sentences.



Maths

This half term we will be learning to tell the time.

Please help your child by looking at analogue clocks around the home and local community. We will be focusing on o'clock, half past, quarter to and quarter past, before learning to tell the time in 5 minute intervals. We will also be learning about data collection, using block diagrams, tally charts and pictograms. Perhaps you could help your child collect some data, such as friend's birthdays, favourite colours or pets, and help them to turn it into a block diagram, tally or pictogram.

Please also continue to practise 2x, 5x and 10x table and continue with numbots.

Geography

In Geography, we will be completing our topic on coasts with a fieldwork trip to Felpham village and beach on Thursday 11th June. In support of this, why not visit the beach in Bognor or Felpham? Talk about the features you see on your journey and while you are there, such as shops, cafes, parks, pubs, beach huts and houses. You could even use Google Earth to look at other coasts in the UK, such as those you may have visited, or would like to visit one day.
